

REMOTE CONTROL PREPARATION

BATTERY INSTALLATION

Install the batteries as the following picture. Be sure + and – terminals are positioned as indicated in the battery compartment (Fig1).

SERVICE LIFE OF BATTERIES

- The batteries normally last for one year although this depends on how often the remote control is used.
- If the remote control fails to work even when it is operated near the player, replace the batteries.
- Use two size AAA dry batteries.

NOTE:

- Do not drop, step on or otherwise impact the remote control. This may damage the parts or lead to malfunction.
- If the remote control is not going to be used for a long time, remove the batteries.

REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION


Point the remote control from no more than about 6m from the remote control sensor and within about 60° of the front of the player (Fig2).

NOTES:

- The operating distance may vary according to the brightness of the room.
- Do not point bright light at remote control sensor.
- Do not place objects between the remote control and the remote control sensor.
- Do not use this remote control while simultaneously operating the remote control of any other equipments.

MAKE SURE ALL THE EQUIPMENTS AND POWER CORD ARE CONNECTED PROPERLY AND THE UNIT IS SET IN CORRECT MODE BEFORE KINDS OF OPERATIONS.

BASIC OPERATIONS

- Press POWER (STANDBY) button on the unit or remote control to power ON the unit (indicator will glow blue); press it again to power OFF (standby mode) the unit (indicator will glow red).
- Press SOURCE button on the unit or remote control to switch the unit to DTV or ATV mode.

SELECT DESIRED PROGRAM

- 1. Press CH+ button to play next channel.
- 2. Press CH- button to play previous channel.
- 3. Press number buttons on remote control directly to select desired program.

NOTE: Press -/-- button repeatedly to switch the digit.

VOLUME CONTROL

- Press VOL+ or VOL- to adjust the level of current volume.

Available range: 0-100.

MUTE CONTROL

- Press MUTE button to mute the sound, press it again to turn on the sound.

SOURCE SETTING

- Press SOURCE button on the unit or remote control to display the sources list.
- Press UP or DOWN navigation button to select desired input source, and then press OK button to confirm selection.

Available options: Satellite, DTV, ATV, AV, SCART, YPbPr, HDMI, PC, USB.

MULTIAUDIO SETTING

- Press AUDIO button on remote control and use navigation buttons to select desired audio language.


NOTE: To enable this function, make sure that the channel you are viewing supports multi-audio languages.

INFORMATION DISPLAY

- Press DISPLAY button on remote control to display information of current program.

EPG TV GUIDE (FOR DTV MODE ONLY)

- Press EPG button on remote control to display program guide.



- Press UP/DOWN navigation button to select preferred program
- Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to switch between left column and right column.

When a program is highlighted (cursor moved to Right column):

- Press YELLOW button to display program guide of previous day.
- Press BLUE button to display program guide of next day.

FAVORITE LIST

When viewing an available channel, press FAV button on remote control to enter Favorite List menu page.

- Press UP or DOWN navigation button to select preferred channel.
- Press OK button to confirm selection.

Note: To add a favorite channel, please refer to the operations of "Channel>Program Edit".



QUICK SELECT

When viewing an available channel, press OK button on remote control to enter Channel List menu page.

- Press UP or DOWN navigation button to select preferred channel.
- Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select a channel group.
- Press OK button to confirm selection.

TELETEXT

- Press TEXT button on remote control to display the available teletext information and press it again to exit the teletext.



TV/RADIO (FOR DTV MODE ONLY)

- Press TV/RADIO button on remote control to switch the unit between TV and radio mode.(DTV only)


SUBTITLE

- Press SUBTITLE button on remote control repeatedly to select desired subtitle.

MEDIA PLAYBACK(USB INPUT)

- Insert a USB memory device into USB slot before following operations.
- Press SOURCE button on the unit or remote control to switch the unit to USB mode or press MEDIA button on remote control.
- Press UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select the file, press OK button to confirm the selection then press PLAY to start the selected file. Repeat the procedure to select/unselect new files.
- Press EXIT button to return to previous menu page.



3. MOVIE

- Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select Movie in the main menu and press OK button to enter it.
- Use navigation buttons to select desired folder or file.
- When selecting files, press RED button to enter submenu and you can delete a file accordingly.
- Use navigation buttons to select a file and press OK button to add to play list.
- Press ▶II button to start playback.
- Press DISPLAY button to call out the tool bar. Use navigation buttons to select desired option and press OK to confirm it.

MAIN MENU

- The unit contains different setting menus. Once the initial programming is entered, it will be remained in the memory until change, and the unit can always be operated under the same conditions.
- The settings will be remained in the memory until the settings are changed, even after setting the player to standby mode.

Common procedure for initial settings

- Press MENU button on the unit or remote control to display the main menu.
- Press UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT navigation buttons to move the cursor.
- Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter submenu.
- -Press UP and DOWN buttons to select the option to adjust
- Press MENU button to save current setting and return to previous menu page.
- Press EXIT button to exit menu page.

First Time Installation

- Connect to power source and turn on this TV, then below setup page will display on the screen.
- Press UP/DOWN navigation button to move the cursor.
- Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select an option.

Language: select the on-screen menu language.

Country: select your country.

Energy Mode: select Home or Store mode.

Tuning Setup

- If above selections are finished, press OK button to call out Tuning Setup.
- Select preferred Tune Type and Digital Type using navigation buttons and press OK button to start auto tuning.

Note: Digital Type is adjustable only under DVB-C mode.



DTV MODE

- Press the SOURCE button on the unit or remote control to select DTV input source.

1. CHANNEL



1.1 TV menu

- Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter it.
- Use navigation buttons to select DVB-T or DVB-C.

1.2 Auto Tuning

- Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter it.
- Use navigation buttons to set the Country, Tune Type and Sorting by LCN.

Note: Scan type and other items are adjustable only when "Antenna" is DVB-C.

- Then press OK to start program tuning.

1.3 ATV Manual Tuning

Current CH: select current channel.

Color System: select available color system. **Sound System:** select available sound system.

Fine Tune: fine tune the frequency.

AFC: turn on/off Automatic Frequency Control.

Search: search available programs.

1.4 DTV Manual Tuning

- Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter it.
- Use LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select the channel. Then press OK button to start searching.

When "Antenna" is DVB-C:

1.4 CADTV Manual Tuning

- Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter it.
- Use navigation buttons to adjust the Frequency, Symbol and QAM Type. Then press OK button to start searching.

1.5 Program Edit

- Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to select the menu.
- Press UP/DOWN navigation button to highlight desired channel.
- Press RED button on remote control to delete highlighted channel.
- Press YELLOW button on remote control to enter MOVE mode. Then use UP/DOWN navigation button to select preferred position and press YELLOW button again to move it.
- Press BLUE button on remote control to skip highlighted channel.
- Press FAV button to set current channel as a favorite channel, and press FAV button again to set it as a normal channel.

1.6 Signal information (works under available TV signals)

This item is used to display signal details, for example: channel number and strength.

1.7 CI information (works under available TV signals)

When an available CAM (Conditional Access Module) card is connected to the CI slot, users can view related information or manage the CAM card.

2. PICTURE



2.1 Picture Mode

- Press UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT navigation buttons to select an option.

Picture Mode: available options: Standard, Mild, Personal, Dynamic.

Contrast / Brightness / Color / Tint / Sharpness: adjustable value: 0-100.

NOTE: Contrast, Brightness, Color and Sharpness are adjustable only when Picture Mode is "User". Tint is adjustable only for NTSC system.

2.2 Color Temperature

This item is used to adjust the optimum color temperature for suitable viewing.

Available options: Normal, Warm, Cold.

2.3 Noise Reduction

Available options: Off, Low, Medium, High

Note: when the TV signal does not have noises we advise to keep this function off.

2.4 SCREEN (for PC/VGA mode only)

2.5 Dynamic CR

Turn on/off dynamic contrast ratio.

3. SOUND



3.1 Sound Mode

- Press UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT navigation buttons to select an option.

Sound Mode: available options: Standard, Music, Movie, Sports, Personal.

Treble / Bass: adjustable value: 0-100.

NOTE: Treble and Bass are adjustable only when Sound Mode is "User".

3.2 Balance

This item is used to adjust the audio output between left and right speaker from -50 to 50.

3.3 Auto Volume

This item is used to set Auto Volume ON or OFF.

3.4 Surround Sound

This item is used to select desired mode of Surround sound.

3.5 S/PDIF Mode

Available options: Auto, PCM, Off.

3.6 AD Switch

This item is used to turn on/off Audio Description function. For Visually Impaired users, this function can help to know a certain scene or action through the narration, instead of see it. **NOTE:** AD Switch function works only when you are viewing programs that contain related narration information.

4. TIME



4.1 Clock

It displays current system time when an available channel was saved.

4.2 Time Zone

This item is used to select desired time zone.

4.3 Off Time

Off Time: available options: Off / Once / Every Day / Mon~Fri / Mon~Sat / Sat~Sun / Sun. *Hour / Minute:* use navigation buttons to adjust the Hour / Minute when Off Time is not "Off".

4.4 On Time

On Time: available options: Off / Once / Every Day / Mon~Fri / Mon~Sat / Sat~Sun / Sun. **Hour / Minute / Source / Channel / Volume:** use navigation buttons to adjust these items when Off Time is not "Off".

4.5 Sleep Timer

This item is used to set the automatic sleep time when no signals.

Available options: Off, 10min, 20min, 30min, 60min, 90min, 120min, 180min, 240min

4.6 Auto Standby

This item is used to select desired Auto Sleep (standby) duration when no operations were done through the remote control.

Available options: Off, 3/4/5 hours.

4.7 OSD Timer

This item is used to select desired OSD menu duration.

Available options: Off, 5/10/15/20/25/30/35 seconds.

5. LOCK

- Press RIGHT navigation button and input the factory default password "0000" using number buttons on remote control.
- Press UP/DOWN navigation button to select preferred item.

NOTE: If you forget the password, please use the universal password "8899".



5.1 System Lock

This item is used to turn on/off Lock System.

5.2 Set Password

- Input the old password using number buttons on remote control and then input your private password twice to finish it.

5.3 Channel Lock

- Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter it.
- Press UP/DOWN navigation button to select the channel which you want to lock.
- Press GREEN button repeatedly to lock/unlock the highlighted channel.

5.4 Parental Guidance

This item is used to select desired program rating.

Available options: Off, 4-18.

5.5 Key Lock

This item is used to lock/unlock TV buttons.

Available options: On, Off.

5.6 Hotel Mode

- Press RIGHT navigation button to enter it.



- Press UP/DOWN navigation button to move the cursor.
- Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select an option.

Hotel Mode: turn on/off Hotel Mode.

Source Lock: turn on/off the lock of available sources.

Default Source: set the default source.

Default Prog: set the default digital program.
Default Volume: set the default volume level.
Max Volume: set the maximum volume level.
Export DataBase: export database to USB device.
Import DataBase: import database from USB device.

Clear Lock: Clear above settings.

6. SETUP



6.1 Language

This item is used to select desired on-screen display language.

6.2 TT Language

This item is used to select desired teletext language.

6.3 Audio Language

- Press RIGHT navigation button to enter it.
- Then you can select desired primary audio language and secondary audio Language.

6.4 Subtitle Language

- Press RIGHT navigation button to enter it.
- Then you can select desired primary subtitle language and secondary subtitle Language.

6.5 Hearing Impaired

This item is used to turn on/off Hearing Impaired function. For Hearing Impaired users, this function can assist help to know a certain scene or action through the caption, instead of hearing it.

NOTE: Hearing Impaired function works only when you are viewing programs that contain related caption information.

6.6 Aspect Ratio

This item is used to adjust the video size.

Available options: Auto, 4:3, 16:9, Zoom1, Zoom2.

NOTE: The available video size may be different for different input source.

6.7 Blue Screen

This item is used to turn on/off Blue Screen. The screen background will turn blue at very weak or no signal condition, if Blue Screen is ON.

6.8 First Time Installation

This item is used to recall the First Time installation menu.

6.9 Energy Mode

This item is used to select Home or Store mode.

6.10 Reset

This item is used to recall factory default settings.

6.11 Software Update (USB)

This item is used to update software through the USB memory device.

6.12 HDMI CEC (Consumer Electronic Control)

- Press RIGHT navigation button to enter it.

To use HDMI CEC function:

- Make sure the HDMI device (Amplifier, etc.) is connected correctly.
- Press SOURCE button on the unit or remote control to select HDMI input source.

HDMI CEC: turn on/off HDMI CEC. HDMI ARC: turn on/off ARC function.

Auto Power: turn on/off Auto Power function.

Device Menu: display the setup menu of other device

connected.



ATV AND OTHER MODES

SATELLITE MODE



This item is used to adjust the picture apply to the TV.

5. Phase

This item is used to adjust the signals transfer speed.

NOTE: For other menu operations in PC-RGB (VGA) mode, please refer to the menu operations of DTV mode.




MAINTENANCE


